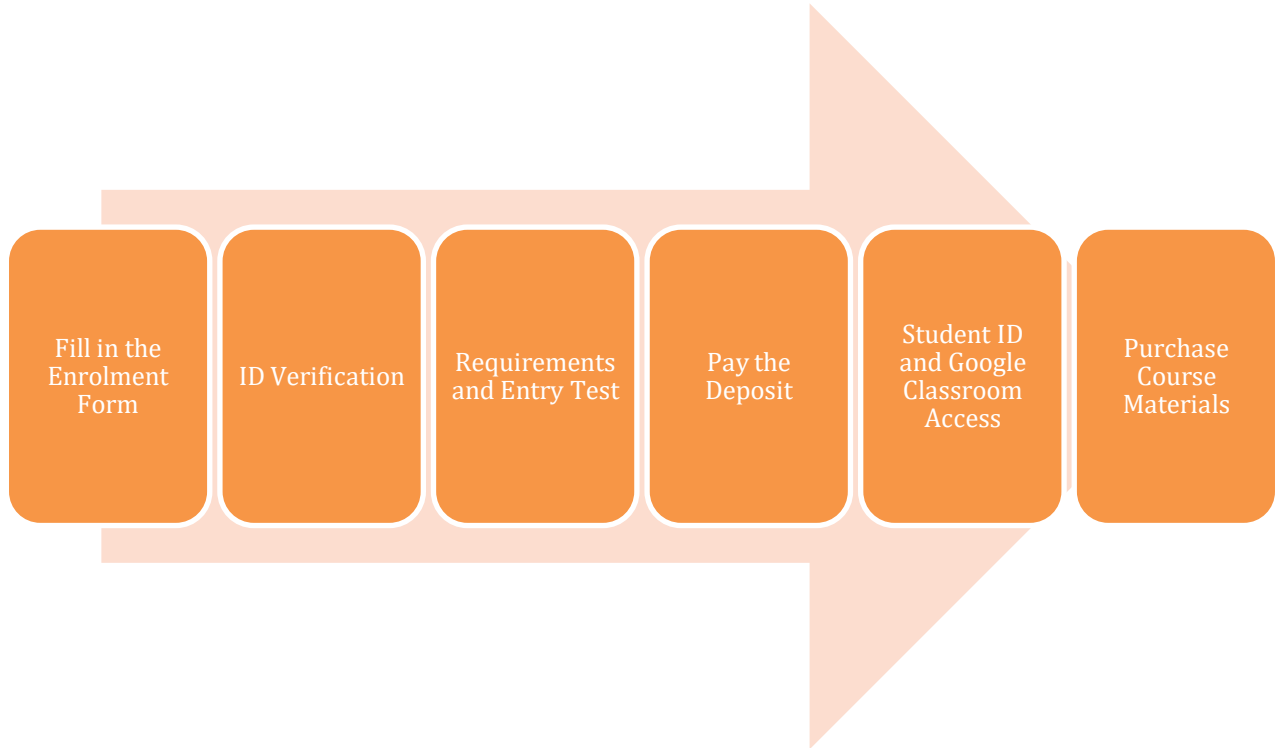




Shatibiy Institute Registration Process

We specialise in delivering a classical and immersive education in the traditional Islamic sciences, offering free courses in all areas of Islamic knowledge.

To enrol in our courses, please follow the steps outlined below:



Step 1: Fill in the Enrolment Form

- Complete the online enrolment form available at: Enrolment Form
- Deadline: Saturday, 6th September 2025 at midnight

Step 2: ID Verification

- Date: Sunday, 7th September 2025
- Time: From Duhr to Asr
- Location: Beaumont Leys Masjid
- Required Documents (bring one of the following):
 - Valid Passport (from any country)
 - UK/EU Driving License
 - EU ID Card
- Other documents may be accepted at the discretion of the Students' Affairs Officer.
- For child registration, the ID must belong to the child.
- If you are unable to attend on this date, contact the Students' Affairs Officer (students@shatibiy-institute.org) to arrange an alternative appointment. Alternative appointments are only considered in case of a valid excuse.

Step 3: Requirements and Entry Test

- Course requirements will be reviewed.
- If applicable, you will be required to pass an entry test exam. Example: Arabic for Non-Native Speakers requires a level assessment to place students in the appropriate level.

Step 4: Pay the Deposit

- A deposit of £100 per student is required.
- This covers all registered courses.
- The deposit will be returned upon successful completion of the course(s).
- The deposit ensures commitment and progress. All courses are free. As such, teachers and staff members draw their motivation from seeing students' progress and succeed in their studies.

Step 5: Student ID and Google Classroom Access

- Once ID and requirements are verified and payment is made:
 - A student ID will be created.
 - The student will be added to Google Classroom.
- Google Classroom will be used to:

- Track student progress
- Distribute class materials
- Assign homework and tasks

Step 6: Purchase Course Materials

- A list of required materials for each course will be provided on the registration day.
- You must purchase the exact materials specified (e.g., the correct publisher for books).
